Ordinance No. 03 - 09 - 2020

Passed 3 - 24 - 20 20

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY DIRECTOR OF THE CITY OF CIRCLEVILLE TO ENTER INTO A DELINQUENT DEBT COLLECTION AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO ATTORNEY GENERAL FOR THE COLLECTION OF CHARGES FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL TRANSPORT SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Circleville is authorized by statute to provide emergency medical transport services for the protection of the health and safety of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the City of Circleville has been providing such emergency transport services and has authorized the Safety Director to contract with a billing agency for the collection of such charges for emergency medical transport services; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code §131.02, the City is authorized to contract with the office of the Attorney General to assist in the collection of delinquent debt owed to the City for such emergency medical transport services; and

WHEREAS, contracting with the office of the Ohio Attorney General for such delinquent debt collection is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Circleville and the same ought to be done.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CIRCLEVILLE, PICKAWAY COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That the Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized to enter into a delinquent debt collection agreement with the Ohio Attorney General for the billing and collection of delinquent charges for emergency medical transport services in accordance with all terms and conditions established by the Ohio Attorney General for such collection

SECTION II. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Circleville, such emergency arising out of the immediate need to enter into such agreement with the Ohio Attorney General to ensure uninterrupted collection of delinquent charges for emergency medical transport services so that this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
