

RECORD OF ORDINANCES

Ordinance No. 07-35-2670 Passed 7-21-, 2020

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE DIRECTOR OF THE CITY OF CIRCLEVILLE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH GOVDEALS.COM TO SELL AND DISPOSE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY OF THE CITY NOT NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE BY INTERNET AUCTION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the various departments within the City are in possession of numerous items of personal property which are no longer needed for City purposes; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the requirements of Ohio Revised Code, these items of personal property are required to be periodically disposed of at public auctions; and

WHEREAS, the City is desirous of obtaining the services of govdeals.com to auction and dispose of these items of personal property; and

WHEREAS, obtaining the services of govdeals.com to provide these property disposition services is in the best interest of the City of Circleville and the same ought to be done.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CIRCLEVILLE, OHIO AS FOLLOWS;

SECTION I: That the Service Director of the City of Circleville is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with govdeals.com to provide auction and disposition of personal property services for the City.

SECTION II: That govdeals.com shall conduct the auctions in accordance with their established general terms and conditions of sale provided online bids shall be accepted for a period of 14 days with all requirements for the pickup and delivery of the property, method of payment and all other terms and restrictions for the sale to be provided on the internet at the time of the auction.

SECTION III: That notice of the intent to sell unneeded, obsolete or unfit municipal personal property by internet auction shall be published in the Circleville Herald at least twice with the second notice to be published not less than 10 nor more than 20 days after the initial notice. Such notice of sale shall also be posted continuously throughout the year in the required City offices as well as on the City's website.

SECTION IV: That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Circleville, such emergency arising out of the immediate need to enter into this agreement for internet sales without unnecessary delay and prior to inclement weather, so this resolution shall take effect and be in force immediate from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
