

SEALED PROPOSAL FOR SWIMMING POOL ACCESSORIES

The City of Circleville Department of Public Service is soliciting sealed proposals for pool accessories that were formerly used in the large swimming pool located within Ted Lewis Park.

The following is a brief description of items available:

"SPEEDKING" Waterslide, original 1991 cost - \$55,000.00. The last time the slide was in operation was the 2010 season. Three phase pump and motor used for two seasons. Engineering calculations, erection and shop drawings are available.

Two - Pumps and motors with strainer (three phase, 20 HP, and 8" flange.)

Six – Stainless steel ladders.

The accessories can be viewed on Tuesday, March 26th from 12:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. at Ted Lewis Park.

Bidders can purchase any item individually or in combination. The City reserves the right to accept proposals based upon those who propose the greatest value to the city.
